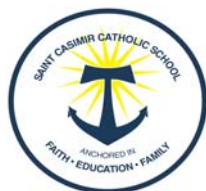

Upcoming Volunteer Hours/Profit Opportunities:

Back to School Night

- 2 volunteer service hour per family for attendance (you must sign-in to receive hours)

Spaghetti Dinner & Family Fun Night

- STAND trained volunteers earn 1 service hour for each hour worked
- 1 volunteer service hour for each dozen of cupcakes or brownies donated (individually wrapped, no cakes or pies)

Color Run/Race for Education

- 80% profit on all donations received
- STAND trained volunteers earn 1 volunteer service hour for each hour worked assisting with day of activities

Baltimore Marathon Cheering Section

- Volunteers earn 1 service hour for each hour worked at the Water Table
- 1 volunteer hour or 100% profit (must turn in receipts) for items donated to the water table. We are looking for cases of water, cases of Gatorade, disposable cups, 3 lbs packs of bananas, or bags of oranges.
