### Maryland 529 Program for K-12 Tuition

Dear Catholic School Principals and Presidents,

We want to take a moment to remind you and your school families of a state and federal tax benefit for savings and payment of *K-12 tuition* allowed under the Maryland 529 College Savings Program. Per federal law, these accounts can be used to pay for, and/or save for, K-12 private education expenses, including tuition. While savings sit in those accounts, the funds are invested through T. Rowe Price in partnership with the State of Maryland and enjoy tax-free growth. Furthermore, if funds go unused for K-12 education, they may be subsequently used for college. Anyone can open a Maryland 529 Account at any time. Here's a printable flyer to share with parents from the State of Maryland.

Maryland law allows for a tax deduction of up to \$2,500 per beneficiary for contributions to each child's account. Parents may deduct up to \$2,500 per beneficiary on contributions each year from their Maryland State income - \$5,000 for two children, \$7,500 for three, etc. (Source: Maryland 529 Program FAQ) For a two-parent household, both parents could open an account for each of the children, thus doubling the tax deduction \*Nothing herein constitutes tax advice. You should consult a tax professional for more information.

Additionally, the State of Maryland has a 529 matching program, which matches up to \$500 in contributions from the State of Maryland. Account holders must apply annually to receive the match. The deadline to apply for this year's State Contribution Program is May 31, 2021.

To be eligible for the Match Program, the account beneficiary must be a Maryland resident and the Account Holder's Maryland taxable income cannot exceed \$112,500 as an individual or \$175,000 as a married couple filing jointly (based on the previous taxable year).
