Basketball:

First.....my apology to Emerson Lawrence for omitting his 4 points scored in the game vs. St. Joe Cockeyville on Feb 1st. Sorry Emerson!

Congratulations to the 4th grade boys' team on posting their FIRST win of the season. While they've been "in" many of their games this season, this was the first big "W" beating St. Joe Fullerton 15-2. Everyone chipped in on this one, playing scrappy defense, taking the SJF ball handler out of his game, controlling the boards on both ends, sharing the ball on offense led to holding the opposition to just one basket. Jack Washo added a basket early to get things rolling , Timmy Mulligan ran the offense, scoring 7 points, including a 3-pointer, shot a pass to Mason Saraullo who scored off the assist notching 4 points for the day, Christos Christopoulos added a bucket to complete the route.

Our 8th grade boys' team, down 2 starters, beat a stubborn St. Mark team 18-15 in overtime. Trailing much of the game, but keeping the score to within 4 points, and with 3 minutes left in regulation, Quinn McCartney appeared leading a comeback, scoring 4 points (including an inbounds "steal and score") tying the game, sending it to overtime.

The 4th grade girls lost a close one to St. John SP 6-2. This team has turned the corner in the last half of the season and has competed in every game. Thanks to a basket by Johanna Hook, the shutout was averted. It should be noted that our Anchors lost to this team in week 3, 12-1, great improvement ladies.

5th grade boys (missing a few starters) lost a tough one to a strong St. Ursula team, 24 to 6 and following the coach's pleas to keep the score under 30. Jack McCartney had a basket and a free-throw, Emerson Lawrence scored 3 points as well.
